Here Comes Senior Olympics!

Participation Is Up 20% from Year Ago, Ranging in Age from 50 to . . . 107!

Northern Virginia Senior Olympics will stand 20 percent higher from last year, with the oldest participant more than double the minimum age of 50 years old.

A total of 831 individuals have registered for the 40th annual competition, with opening ceremonies slated for Saturday, Sept. 10 at 9:30 a.m. at Thomas Jefferson Community Center in Arlington, followed by track competition indoors at the facility.

Running through Sept. 24,

25 different venues, with participants competing in 70-plus events.

"Pickleball, track, field and table tennis have garnered the most registrants," said Herb Levitan, who chairs the non-profit organizing committee.

The most seasoned of competitors is Vera Punke of Arlington, who has registered to play duplicate bridge. She is 107 years
